Greetings Haskell Family. We will be celebrating our 70th Anniversary in March 2023. There are 70 Scriptures that we would like the entire body of Haskell to reflect upon over our 70-year journey. We ask that you will meditate upon them in preparation for our 70th year celebration in March 2023.

One effective way to meditate is to ask a question or make a comment on the passage. Do that for each passage below.

1. **Here is an example: Mark 11:23**

For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

Does that mean a person can have anything that he says out of his mouth? OR 'Whoever' gives everybody access!

The Scripture references have been placed at the end of the passages. Challenge yourselves and see if you can quote where the passage is from before you look at the Scripture reference.

2. For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God not by works, so that no one can boast. **Ephesians 2:8-9**

3. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!
2 Corinthians 5:17

4. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. **Hebrews 13:8**

5. "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." **Jeremiah 29:11**

6. I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service. **Romans 12:1**

7. Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it *spring* the issues of life. **Proverbs 4:23**

8. Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. ² And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband **Revelation 21:1-2**

9. Peter replied, “Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. **Acts 2:38**

10. I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. **Psalms 119:11**
-
11. Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men. **Colossians 3:23**
-
12. Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. **Philippians 4:6-7**
-
13. You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world. **1 John 4:4**

14. Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, ⁴ who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God. **2 Corinthians 1:3-4**

15. Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, “Cursed *is* everyone who hangs on a tree” **Galatians 3:13**
-
16. Forever, O LORD, your word is settled in heaven **Psalms 119:89**
-
17. Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, ²⁶ that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, ²⁷ that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. **Ephesians 5:25-27**

18. All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness. -**2 Timothy 3:16**

19. And He shall give you the desires of your heart. -**Psalm 37:4**

20. The LORD will perfect *that which* concerns me; Your mercy, O LORD, *endures* forever; Do not forsake the works of Your hands. **Psalm 138:8**

21. *There is* one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; ⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism; ⁶ one God and Father of all, who *is* above all, and through all, and in you all. **Ephesians 4:4-6**

22. "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—His good, pleasing and perfect will." **Romans 12:2**

23. But you, keep your head in all situations, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, discharge all the duties of your ministry. **2 Timothy 4:5**

24. Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; **Proverbs 3:5**

25. For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. ¹⁷ For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith." **Romans 1:16-17**

26. Then to Adam He said, "Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat of it': "Cursed *is* the ground for your sake; In toil you shall eat *of* it all the days of your life. **Genesis 3:17**

27. His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence, by which he has granted to us his precious and very great promises, so that through them you may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped from the corruption that is in the world because of sinful desire. **2 Peter 1:3-4**

28. Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. **John 14:6**

29. "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all *who are* in the house. ¹⁶ Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven. **Matthew 5:14-16**

30. Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. **Philippians 4:8**
-
31. For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God; **Romans 3:23**
-
32. For the flesh sets its desire against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these are in opposition to one another, so that you may not do the things that you please. **Galatians 5:17**
-
33. No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it. **1 Corinthians 10:13**
-
34. But as for you, you meant evil against me; *but* God meant it for good, in order to bring it about as *it is* this day, to save many people alive. **Genesis 50:20**
-
35. Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; **2 Corinthians 10:5**
-
36. But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), ⁶ and raised *us* up together, and made *us* sit together in the heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus, ⁷ that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in *His* kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. **Ephesians 2:4-7**

37. Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth. **2 Timothy 2:15**
-

38. We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. **2 Corinthians 5:20**

39. When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. ² And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and *one* sat upon each of them. ⁴ And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. **Acts 2:1-4**

40. But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always *be* ready to *give* a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear; **1 Peter 3:15**

41. A man's heart plans his way, but the LORD directs his steps. **Proverbs 16:9**

42. And He Himself gave some *to be* apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, ¹² for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, ¹³ till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; **Ephesians 4:11-13**

43. Wealth gained by dishonesty will be diminished, but he who gathers by labor will increase. **Proverbs 13:11**

44. When they heard *this*, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. ⁶ And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied. ⁷ Now the men were about twelve in all. **Acts 19: 5-7**

45. Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore, pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest." **Matthew 9:37-38**

46. And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." **Matthew 28:18-20**

47. Therefore, God also gave them up to uncleanness, in the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among themselves, ²⁵ who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen. **Romans 1:24-25**

48. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth. **Acts 1:8**

49. Everyone who acknowledges me publicly here on earth, I will also acknowledge before my Father in heaven. ³³ But everyone who denies me here on earth, I will also deny before my Father in heaven. **Matthew 10:32-33**

50. Submit yourselves to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. **James 4:7**

51. Bless the Lord O my soul and forget not all His benefits; Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases. **Psalms 103:2-3**

52. See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, ¹⁶ redeeming the time, because the days are evil. **Ephesians 5:15-16**

53. But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. **Matthew 6:33**

54. Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ, ⁴ just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, ⁵ having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, ⁶ to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved. **Ephesians 1:3-6**

55. Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. ¹⁵ And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him. **1 John 5:14-15**

56. Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. ²² On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?' ²³ And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.' **Matthew 7:21-23**

57. Thus says the LORD of hosts: 'In those days ten men from every language of the nations shall grasp the sleeve of a Jewish man, saying, "Let us go with you, for we have heard *that God is with you.*"

Zechariah 8:23

58. Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith. **1 Peter 5:8-9**

59. When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, ¹⁷ that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore *our* sicknesses." **Matthew 8:16-17**

60. But this *I say*: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. ⁷ *So let each one give* as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. ⁸ And *God is able* to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all *things*, may have an abundance for every good work. **2 Corinthians 9:6-8**

61. So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. **Romans 10:17**

62. Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. **Hebrews 11:1**

63. But you have not so learned Christ, ²¹ if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus: ²² that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, ²³ and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, ²⁴ and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

Ephesians 4:20-24

64. "The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon Me, because the LORD has anointed me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *those who are* bound; ² to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn, ³ to console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified."
Isaiah 61:1-3

65. Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' says the Lord of hosts. **Zechariah 4:6**

66. For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. **Ephesians 2:10**

67. Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. **Genesis 1:3**

68. And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. **Matthew 16:18**

69. As it is written: "There is none righteous, no, not one;" **Romans 3:10**

70. But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life. **Revelation 21:27**
